Season 5 Competitions !!!!

Parents must indicate their preference for either the travel or non-travel team no later than July 1st. In October, parents will be required to complete a survey to inform us of any scheduling conflicts and confirm their commitment to the competitions for the season.

When considering Travel vs Non-Travel team please note the following

- **Travel Teams** are working towards competing at nationals in Nashville, Tn. Dream Girls are allowed to miss no more than one travel competition during the regular season in order to qualify and local competitions in Houston and surrounding areas are mandatory. Travel logistics, including hotel accommodations and transportation, are the responsibility of the parents.
- **Non-Travel and Show Teams** will compete in Houston and surrounding areas throughout the regular season (e.g., Rosenberg, Galveston, Beaumont, etc.). The final competition of the season will be either in Dallas, TX, or at the Kalahari Resort in Round Rock, TX. If a travel competition is offered to non-travel or show team, parents will have the option to decline attendance.

We understand that life can be unpredictable—if you encounter any scheduling conflicts or extenuating circumstances, we will do our best to work with everyone.

Competition Fees

Competition Deposit

All Dream Girls are required to pay a 50% deposit for competition fees by November 1, 2025. This deposit will be applied to the competitions your child will participate in. In January 2026, parents will receive a statement outlining any remaining competition fees for the season. Please note that Dream Girls will not be registered for competitions until the deposit is paid.

Dream Big Week/ Weekend!!!!

This clinic kicks off Season 5 and introduces new Dream families to the Bayou City Dream organization. Girls will have the opportunity to meet returning Dream Girls, learn choreography, and perform in the Missouri City Juneteenth Parade. Girls who are registered for Season 5 can participate at no cost. For girls who are not registered, the cost to participate is \$45.

Tumbling Classes

BCD partners with a tumbling gym in both North and South Houston to offer tumbling lessons for the girls. While the lessons are optional, they are highly recommended for all participants. The lessons will be scheduled on a designated day each week for BCD girls. BCD will handle the registration with the gym, and parents will complete the financial obligations directly with the gym. Cost is between \$90- \$110 each month per girl.

Evaluations- Everyone will make a Team!!!!

Registered Dream Girls will participate in a clinic where they will learn a cheer and dance routine, which they will perform at evaluations on 7/8/2025. The evaluations help coaches determine which team will best support each cheerleader's success. Team placements will be posted by 7/10/2025. Evaluations also guide us in selecting the appropriate dance style and cheer level for your child. As evaluations approach, we will provide more details on the criteria used for team placements.

Summer Information

May will feature skill-specific classes to help girls prepare for the upcoming season. These classes will include exercises, conditioning, cheer skills, and dance techniques. It will also serve as an opportunity for families to determine if BCD is a good fit for them.

June will include skill specific classes to support the growth of every registered Dream Girl. The classes are not mandatory but strongly encouraged.

July practices will be held on Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday, and will be scheduled by team. The North Houston Dream Girls practice schedule will be determined based on the number of registered Dream Girls and team placements.

Important Organization Information

We are a Christ centered organization.

During The Season

- If we determine that a Dream Girl is capable of joining additional teams, we will consult with the parents to collaboratively maximize the child's potential.
- We periodically plan team outings and bonding experiences for the girls.
- Girls may be given opportunities to perform at local sporting events or functions.
- We understand your child may have other activities and interests. We will accommodate schedules as much as we can.

Financial Information

- Fundraisers will be available, starting in July to offset the cost of the season; however, the registration fee must be paid in full before a child is eligible to participate.
- We have payment plan options available and we will work with parents.
- Late fees will be applied if payments are not received by the specified due date.
- If families experience financial difficulties during the season, we ask that parents speak with a coach before making the decision to withdraw their child from the team.

Competition Information

- Once a competition fee has been paid, no refunds will be issued unless the competition is canceled or BCD coaches withdraw from the event. *If a parent notifies us in a timely manner that their child will not be participating in a competition, they will not incur any charges for that competition.*
- Please be aware that while we will make every effort to follow the competition schedule provided to parents, circumstances during the season may require adjustments to the locations or dates of competitions. When changes occur, we will notify parents promptly and will do our best to accommodate prior scheduling conflicts.
- For travel teams some competitions may require the team to arrive the day before the competition.

Practice Expectations

- Please wear BCD apparel or all black athletic clothes
- Please arrive on time and no more than 20 minutes late.
- If your child must be late please notify a coach as soon as possible.
- Hair must be out of child's face when they arrive to practice
- The week leading to competition, practice is MANDATORY or your daughter risks not performing and registration fees will not be refunded.

Attendance Expectations

Competitive cheer and dance requires a significant time commitment. We require all girls to participate in the scheduled practices and competitions unless prior arrangements have been made with the coaches for non-participation.

Competition Expectations

Arrive for competitions at the scheduled arrival time. For travel competitions, Dream Girls must arrive on the scheduled day.

Dream Girls must wear the hairstyle designated for the team's competition. Dream Girls must wear the team's performance makeup. Parents are required to accompany their child to travel competitions unless alternative arrangements are made.

Expectation of a Dream Girl

All participants are expected to be positive role models and demonstrate sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy at all times. They must offer positive support for teammates, coaches, officials, players, and spectators at every gathering or event.

Each cheerleader/dancer is expected to conduct themselves respectfully toward coaches, teammates, and others. This includes their speech, actions, and attitude, whether during practices, competitions, or community events.

Cheerleaders/Dancers are prohibited from posting negative comments about teammates, coaches, officials, other teams, or spectators on any platform (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.). NO GOSSIP ALLOWED! This includes gossip about teammates, other teams, coaches, cheer families, or board members.

Expectation of Parents

If there is an issue, please email, text, or call Coach Erica to discuss it. Do not question or confront coaches in front of athletes or parents. Instead, please arrange a time and place to speak with coaches privately.

Be sure to check your emails and the team app regularly for updates and information. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to stay informed about what is happening with your child's team.

Parents are expected not to post negative comments on any websites or in chat rooms about teammates, coaches, officials, other teams, spectators, etc. (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, SnapChat, etc.).

NO GOSSIP ALLOWED! This includes gossip about teammates, other teams, coaches, cheer families, or board members.

Disciplinary Policy


First Offense- Conversation with child
